COP holders were displaced by Agency action generally during the 1960s and 1970s or are descendants of someone who was displaced.

#### <u>Displaced Tenants Housing</u> <u>Preference (DTHP):</u>

Tenants displaced by no-fault eviction, fire, unaffordable rent due to expiring affordability restrictions or displaced from unlawful residential units a preference in affordable housing lotteries.
